



TOWN CLERK'S REPORT
SPECIAL STATE ELECTION

Tuesday, the Nineteenth Day of January, 2010

In accordance with posted Warrants for Special State Election, the inhabitants of the Town of Foxborough, qualified to vote in elections met in the John J. Ahern Middle School, 111 Mechanic Street, in Precincts No. 1, No. 2, No. 3, No. 4, and No. 5.

The polls opened at 7:00 A.M. with Warden Kathleen M. Brady in charge of all precincts.

At 8:00 P.M., the polls were closed, and the ballots were sorted and counted. The number of ballots agreed with the checklists, and it was announced that the

number of votes cast was seven thousand three hundred seventy-one (7,371). One thousand three hundred three (1303) registered voters voted in Precinct No. 1; one thousand five hundred eleven (1511) in Precinct No. 2; one thousand five hundred forty-eight (1548) in Precinct No. 3; one thousand four hundred ninety-five (1495) in Precinct No. 4; and one thousand five hundred fourteen (1514) in Precinct. No.5. The percentage of registered voters who voted was 69.2%. At the time of the election, there were ten thousand six hundred sixty-four (10,664) inhabitants registered to vote.
